



DOG PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Dog Park is restricted to use by owners and residents of Old Fort Bay and their approved guests from 6am to 10pm daily.
2. Dog waste must be removed and disposed of properly in waste receptacles provided.
3. Dogs must be supervised and under the control of the dog Owner/ Handler at all times
4. Owners/ Handlers must be present and remain within the confines of the dog park at all times. Dogs must not be left unattended.
5. Dogs are the sole responsibility of the dog Owner/ Handler.
6. Dog owners are responsible for the behavior of the dog.
7. Dog Owners are solely responsibility for any injury or loss caused by their dog however arising.
8. Dog Owners/ Handlers must be over the age of 16 and capable of handling and managing their dog.
9. The number of dogs permitted in the dog park is limited to two dogs per Owner/ Handler.
10. Dogs known to be aggressive by their breed or behavior are not permitted in the Dog Park.
11. Aggressive behavior including but not limited to fighting, growling, baring teeth, biting is not permitted.
12. Any dog deemed to be displaying aggressive behavior must be immediately removed by the Owner/ Handler barring which the POA reserves the right to remove the dog or call the relevant authorities to have the dog removed from the community permanently. The POA has a zero aggressive dog policy.
13. The POA reserves the right to ban any dog from the Dog Park.
14. Dog grooming is not permitted in the Dog Park.
15. Any damage caused by dogs must be immediately repaired and remedied including but not limited to holes created by dogs during use.
16. No food including dog or food for human consumption are permitted in the Dog Park.
17. Smoking is not permitted in the dog park.
18. Dog training is not permitted within the Dog Park.
19. Dogs that are unwell or suffering injury are not permitted in the Dog Park.
20. Dogs must be collared with owners' details.
21. Puppies under the age of four months are not permitted in the Dog Park.
22. Dog toys are not permitted within the Dog Park.

23. Dogs must be leashed at all times save when in the Dog Park area. Dog owners/ handlers must be vigilant and identify and act when appropriate to leash a dog. Dog leashes must be ready for use by the Owner/ Handler.
24. Overcrowding of the Dog Park should be avoided for the safety of dogs and persons using the Dog Park.
25. No trash or debris should be left within the Dog Park.
26. Dog Owners/ Handlers are expected to act reasonably in the interest of all Dog Park users.
