

OLD FORT BAY FIREARM RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are made pursuant to and in accordance with the Bahamas Firearms Act, Chapter 213 of the Statute Laws of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas ("the Firearms Act") and shall be observed by all owners, residents agents or invitees of Old Fort Bay.

Prohibited Activities

- 1. "Prohibited Weapons" shall include, but not be limited to, revolvers, pistols, rifles, pellet guns, BB guns of any make or model or any kind.
- 2. No person shall bring, use, discharge, or carry any prohibited weapon in any Common Area within Old Fort Bay.
- 3. No person, except any law enforcement officer shall fire or discharge any prohibited weapon within Old Fort Bay.
- 4. No person shall bring, use, discharge, or carry any prohibited weapon in any area utilized by owners, residents or in the vicinity of areas frequented by owners, residents their guests or agents within Old Fort Bay.
- 5. The use of armed guards within Old Fort Bay is strictly prohibited without the express written permission of the Old Fort Bay Property Owners Association.
- 6. Prohibited weapons shall not be used to intimidate owners, residents their guests or agents.

7. The possession of firearm ammunition in public or common areas or in the vicinity of areas frequented by owners, residents their guests or agents of any kind or description is prohibited.

Duties of Owners

- 8. Any owner that owns a firearm, shall, in accordance with the legislation obtain a government issued firearms license upon its issuance and shall apply for the renewal as necessary thereafter.
- 9. The use or the suspicion of use of any prohibited weapon and firearm by any Owner within Old Fort Bay must be immediately reported to the Old Fort Bay Property Owners Association
- 10. Should a complaint be lodged concerning prohibited firearm usage or possession, the matter shall be referred to the Old Fort Bay Property Owner's Association Board of Directors for investigation and thereafter as appropriate to the Royal Bahamas Police Force.
